Expectations and Responsibilities During Online Learning at MILTON

During the time that the school building is closed and we will be learning and interacting in online classes, we will be following a specific set of expectations for behavior and learning.

Expectations:

- Set up a learning area for yourself where you will keep your Chromebook, books, and supplies. It should be at a desk or table with a chair. This is where you will do your school work.
- When you sit down in your learning area you are ready to learn, just like you would be in your classroom.
- Do not bring toys or other objects to your learning area unless your teacher asks you to.
- Your teachers will be taking attendance for Zoom classes and you are expected to be there; you are expected to check Google Classroom as directed by your teachers and complete the assignments you have there. Parents, if your child is sick or will be unable to join us digitally for the day, please email the teachers.
- When you are working online with other people, either on Zoom (live) or on Google Docs or any other digital platform, you are expected to follow the same rules of computer use as at school:
 - You must be respectful, on-topic, and appropriate in everything you write or say.
 - You may not edit or change someone else's work without their permission.
 - You may not change the settings on a Zoom meeting or any document or anything else that comes from a teacher or another student.
 - o If you are in a Zoom class, you must have your video on.
